

Minutes of Meeting Held at Cokeville, Wyoming
on Monday, October 31, 1955.

Meeting was called to order at 7:30 P. M. by State Senator Reed Dayton.

After introductions tendered Mr. Dayton called upon Mr. Wallace N. Jibson, U. S. Geological Hydraulic Engineer, who briefly described the proposed working of the pending Bear River Compact and then discussed the importance and necessity of having installed proper headgates and measuring devices, and offered suggestions as to kind and size of headgate best suited to each particular ditch or canal.

Mr. Dayton then called on Mr. George Thatcher, Soil Conservationist, to state as to procedure and help in payment through the A. S. C.

Mr. Dayton then called on Mr. Murray M. Wilkes, Representative of A. S. C., who stated the amount that may be available to help in construction of headgates.

Mr. Earl Lloyd was then called upon, who made statement pertaining to type of construction in stream channel control.

Mr. Welch, representative of Armco Manufacturing Company, stated where he can be contacted.

Mr. Lloyd then made the statement as to necessity of having headgates and measuring devices installed in order to affect a proper administration of water.
